- Who are military-connected children?
- Military service impacts families
 - o In US: 1.3 million students have service member parents
 - o In SC: 12,335 students have service member parents

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Introduction

- What are intergenerational learning experiences?
- Geographic separation disrupts learning experiences between generations within a family

 Gap in the literature around intergenerational learning experiences for military-connected children

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Research Question

What is the current state of research on intergenerational learning experiences for military-connected children?

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Military-Connectedness

Family Separation

- Immediate and extended family
- The deployment cycle
- Increased emotional challenges in children

Residential Mobility

- Non-routine school changes
- 9 moves K-12 school career
- Increased behavior problems
- Decreased engagement
- Stalled reading growth

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Intergenerational Learning Experiences

Benefits

- Sociocultural competence
- Emotional regulation
- Identity formation
- Engagement in learning

Contexts

- Traditionally in the family
- Designed community programs

Discussion

- Connections not explored thoroughly in literature
- Commonalities support opportunities for overlap
- Enhanced community relationships could help support militaryconnected children and families in future programming

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Recommendations for Future Research

- Intergenerational community programs for military-connected students
 - Implementation and evaluation
- Additional supports for military-connected students and extended family
- Technology-enhanced intergenerational learning for militaryconnected students
